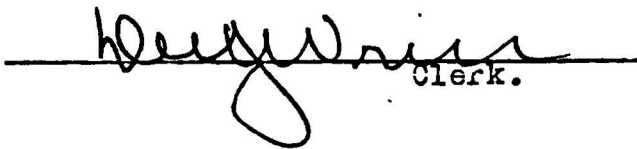

The Report of John C. Friend as Justice of the Peace, was recieved and ordered filed.

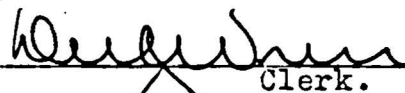
Receipt of fees collected by Edw. McAtee recieved and ordered filed.
