



SPECIAL SESSION

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS NOV. 13th 1911.

Board met this 13th day of Nov. A. D. 1911, in special session, pursuant to a call duly made by Chairman W. A. McKay, for the purpose of taking up the matter of rebatement of some of the sheep men which have been assesed in Routt County and also in the County of Carbon for the years of 1908 and 1910. And to transact any other business which may come before the board.

Roll call showing present Commissioners D. C. Jones Evan Veitch, W. A. McKay chairman and Dee J. Wren, Clerk.

Proceedings were had as follows-

The matter of building or re-building a bridge across cole creek in the North West part of the County, was brought to the attention of the Board, setting forth the necessity of having same placed in at once, F. C. Speyer putting in a bid of \$65.00 for the construction of same it was ordered by the Board that the said F. C. Speyer be instructed to build such bridge for the cost above mentioned.

The petition from The Wyoming Wool Growers Association, asking for a refund of 1908 and 1910 taxes in amount of the number of days which they were compelled to pay taxes up stock, which were run in Routt County Colo for a part of the above mentioned years, was taken up. and after due consideration, it was ordered that the tax would be rebated such owners as were thus doubly assesed, for the exact number of days these owners were in Routt County Colo. As per agreement made between the Counties of Routt and Carbon.

It was moved by Chairman McKay that the County purchase a site for a poor farm. Motion duly seconded by Commissioner Veitch.

Upon vote being called resulting as follows; McKay Aye, Veitch Aye Jones Aye. Chairman McKay ordered that a call for proposed sites for said farm be submitted to the office of the County Clerk on or before noon on the 5th day of Dec. A. D. 1911. To be considered at that time and the Board will carefully invistigate each proposition submitted and further reserve the right to refuse any or all propositions.

And it is Further ordered that a call for such propositions for sites for poor farm be advertised for in the manner prescribed by law.

Verbal report as to the necessity of putting in piling ect, at the bridge across the Platte River at Fort Steel, was submitted, thereupon was ordered that the County Clerk advertise for bids for the construction of such work. It consisting of 10 inch piling 12 ft long, to be set five feet apart along the river bank for a distance of 20 yards below bridge and 130 yards above, said piling to be faced 2 inch plank 8 inches running from 3 to four feet. Bids to be received up to noon the 5th day of Dec. A. D. 1911 at the office of the County Clerk.

At the request of Road Supervosor Milliken, it is hereby ordered that I. E. Vivien have necessary improvements made upon the County Road near Pathfinder. Such work consisting of blasting of Rock from the Road way.. Bills were acted upon as follows:-
