Board met pursuant to adjournment of Dec. 29th . Roll call showing present Commissioners D. C Jones, Evan Veitch, W. A. McKay Chairman, and Deed J. Wren Clerk.

WHEREAS a Petetion subscribed by the applicant and also by not less than a majority of the Electorâ residing within the diesriect comprising the proposed Townsite of Dixon and containing the boundaries thereof and the quantity of land embraced wherein according to the verified survey thereof and the resident population contained therein as shown by the verified census thereof, and also the names of the proposed town to-wit Dixon, Said petetion asking for the incorporation of said Town, which said petetion has attached thereto the affidavits of three electors verifying the facts therein alleged, which said petetion had attached thereto a verfied copy of the notice given showing that the same was posted at three public places within the limits of such proposed Town and remained posted for twenty one days and where the verified survey map and cansus could be examined, and also the date when said petetion would be fuled with the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County Wyoming and application made thereon for the appointment of hree Inspectors to at once call and Election of the qualified Electors within such proposed Town. And the Board of Commissioners of-said-County-~~after-hearing-all-parties-interested-in-such-application, who-appeared-before-it and~~ being satisfied that all requirements of Chapter 120 of the compiled Statutes of Wyoming ^{with the excep of 1910} for 1910 have fully been complied with, and that such territory contains the requisite population ^{accord to verifd census of 1910} does hereby order that E. W.
