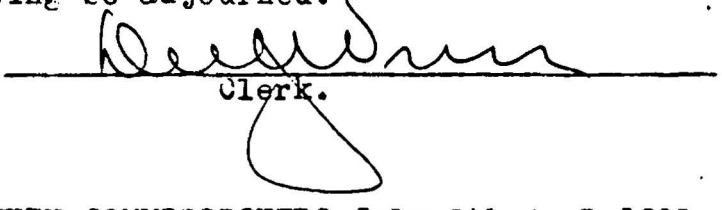


PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS JULY 4th A. D. 1911.
