## PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, JUNE 6th, A. D. 1912.

Board met pursuant to adjournment of June 6th, Roll call showing present Commissioners D. C. Jones, Evan Veitch, Wm. A. McKay Chairman and Dee J. Wren Clerk.

Commissioner of Taxation again took up the matter of classifying the lands of Carbon County, going into many details. There were also present a number of the Land owners of the County, especially the owners of desert or grazing lands. Opinions were express pro and con over the different valuations of lands. The owners holding that unwatered grazing lands should not be assessed at more than \$1.00 per acre, The Commissioner of Taxation holding that there should be a different classification placed upon these lands, \$1.00 being sufficient for some lands but others should be rated higher, taking into consideration, whether the lands could be used for grazing purposes three months, six months or the whole year, and classify and set the valuations accordingly.

Adjournment was made to 2 o'clock P. M.
