



The matter of appointment of a care taker or superintendent of the County Poor Farm was taken up.

After due consideration, as to the best way handling same, and the name of A. T. Schank being presented, it was regularly moved by Commissioner McKay and seconded by Commissioner Day, that A. T. Schank be appointed as Supervisor of the County Poor Farm at Dixon, if the following terms were agreed upon.

1st That the salary be \$100.00 per month for A. T. Schank and wife.

2nd That they furnish Board for themselves.

3rd That they be allowed a garden spot, and also feed for a cow.

4th That they be paid by the County 25 cents for each meal furnished to the inmates of the Farm.

5th That the duties of said Supervisor be for the caring of the inmates, working on farm ect. as instructed by the Board of County Commissioners.

Motion declared carried by Chairman McKay.

The matter of appointing a paper within the County as the Official Paper of Carbon County was taken up.

It was ordered that a ballot be taken in secret.

Ballots were so cast, and the County Clerk appointed as teller.
