PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, JULY, 10th. 1914.

Board met this 10th. day of July A. D. 1914, at 10 o'clock A. M . pursuant to adjournment of July, 9th. 1914. Roll call showing present, Commissioners D. C. Jones, Robt. A. Day, Wm. A. Mc Kay, Chairman and L. B. Magor, Clerk.

Proceedings were had as follows, to-wit:-

ROAD DISTRICTS.

Owing to the necessary changes to be made in the two Road Districts in Carbon County, the following districts are hereby established, in complianced with Section 2547. Session Laws of Wyoming 1913, regarding the dividing of the County into Road Districts:-

ROAD DISTRICT NO. 1.

Road District No. 1, shall comprise all that part of Carbon County lying west of a line described as follows:-

Beginning at the intersection of the line between Ranges 85 and 86 and the Colorado line; thence north on said line to the N. E. Corner of Township 13, N. R. 86 W. ; there

west of the line between Townships 13 and 14 to the S.E. Corner of Section 31, Twp. 14 N. R. 86 W.; thence North on the line between Sections 31 and 32 and 29 and 30, to the NE Corner of Sec. 30, Twp. 14. N. R. 86 W. thence West on the section line between Secs. 19 and 30 to the range line between Ranges 86 and 87; thence north on line between Ranges 86 and 87 to the N. W. Corner of Twp. 14, N. R. 86 W. ~~###~~ thence east along the line between Twps. 14 and 15 to the N. E. Corner of Twp. 14, N. R. 86 W. ; thence North along line between Ranges 85 and 86 to the line between Twps. 16 and 17; thence west along line between Twps. 16 and 17 to line between Ranges 87 and 88; thence north on line between Ranges 87 and 88, ~~###~~ to the line between Twps. 17 and 18; thence east along line between Twps. 17 and 18 to line between Ranges 85 and 86; thence north along line between Ranges 85 and 86 to the line between Twps. 18 and 19; thence east on line between Twps. 18 and 19 to line between Ranges 84 and 85; thence north on line between Ranges 84 and 85 to line between Twps. 24 and 25; thence east on line between Twps. 24 and 25 to the North Platte River; thence northerly along the North Platte River to the line between Secs. 18 and 19 Twp. 27 N. R. 84 W; thence west along Section Line between Secs. 18 and 19 to the line between Ranges 84 and 85; thence north along line between Ranges 84 and 85 to the north line of Carbon County, Wyoming.

Road District No. 2. shall comprise all that part of Carbon County, Wyoming, lying east of the above described line.

In compliance with Chapter 146 of the Compiled Statutes of Wyoming for 1910, the Board established election Districts as follows, also Election Precincts in the several Districts.

ELECTION DISTRICTS. DISTRICT NO.1. RAWLINS.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Election District No. 1.

Commencing at the Township 20 on the line between Ranges 85 and 86, thence north along said Range lines 85 and 86, to the line between Townships 24 and 25; thence along the line between Townships 24 and 25 to the boundary line between Carbon County and Sweetwater County; thence along the line between Carbon and Sweetwater Counties to the line between Townships 19 and 20, thence east along said line between Townships 19 and 20 to the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO.2. FERRIS AND SEMINOE.

Ferris and Seminoe District No. 2. shall consist of all that territory embraced within the following boundary: Beginning at the South West Corner of Township 25, N. R. 89 W.; thence east of a line between Township 24 and 25 to the North Platte River; thence Northwesterly along the North Platte River to the line between sections 18 and 19 Township 27, N. R. 84 W. thence west along the line between sections 18 and 19, Twp. 27, N. R. 84 W. to the line between Ranges 84 and 85; thence north along the line between Ranges 84 and 85 to the north line of Carbon County; thence west along the line between Carbon and Natrona Counties to the line between Carbon and Fremont County, thence ~~###~~ south along the west line of Carbon County to place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 3. FORT STEELE.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Fort Steele Election District No. 3.

Beginning at the South East Corner of Township 20 on the line between Ranges 84

and 85; thence north on said line between Ranges 84 and 85 to the line between Townships 24 and 25, thence west along said line between townships 24 and 25 to the line between Ranges 85 and 86; thence south along said line between Ranges 85 and 86 to the line ~~between~~ between Townships 19 and 20; thence east along said line between Townships 19 and 20 to the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 4. LEO.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Leo Election District No. 4.

Beginning at the Southeast Corner of Township 24, N. R. 81 W. thence north along the line between Ranges 80 and 81 to the north line of Carbon County; thence west along the north line of Carbon County to the line between Ranges 84 and 85; thence south along the line between Ranges 84 and 85 to the line between sections 18 and 19, Twp. 27. N. R. 84 W. ; thence east along the line between Sections 18 and 19 Twp. 27. N. R. 84 W. to the North Platte River thence southeasterly along the North Platte River to the line between Townships 24 and 25; thence east along the line between Townships 24 and 25 to the NW Cor. of Twp. 24. N. R. 83W.; thence south to SW corner of Twp. 24. N. R. 83 W.; thence east along the line between townships 23 and 24 to the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 5. MEDICINE BOW.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Medicine Bow Election District No. 5.

Beginning at a point on the boundary line between Carbon and Albany Counties and on the line between Townships 21 and 22, Range 77 W. ; thence north on said eastern boundary line of Carbon County to the North East Corner of Carbon County; thence west along the northern boundary line of Carbon County to the line between Ranges 80 and 81; thence south on said line between ranges 80 and 81 to the line between Townships 23 and 24; thence east on said line between townships 23 and 24 to the line between ranges 78 and 79, thence south on said line between ranges 78 and 79 to the line between townships 21 and 22; then thence east on said line between townships 21 and 22 to the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 6. HANNA.

All that territory embraced in Townships 21, 22, and 23, in Ranges 81, 82 and 83 w. shall be known as Hanna Election District No. 6.

District No. 7. CARBON.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Carbon Election District No. 7.

Beginning at the south east corner of Township 22 on the line between Ranges 78 and 79; thence north on said line between Ranges 78 and 79 to the line between Townships 23 and 24, thence west on said line between Townships 23 and 24 to the line between Ranges 80 and 81; thence south on said line between Ranges 80 and 81 to the line between Townships 21 and 22; thence east on said line between Townships 21 and 22 to the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 8. ELK MOUNTAIN.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Elk Mountain Election District No. 8.

Beginning at the boundary line between Carbon and Albany Counties and on the line

to the line between Townships 21 and 22; thence west on said line between Townships 21 and 22 to the line between Ranges 80 and 81; thence south on said line between Ranges 80 and 81 to the line between Townships 19 and 20; thence east on said line between Townships 19 and 20 to the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 9. ROCK DALE.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Rock Dale Election District No. 9.

Beginning on the boundary line between Carbon and Albany Counties and on the line between Townships 16 and 17, thence north on said County line to the line between Townships 19 and 20; thence west on said line between Townships 19 and 20 to the line between Ranges 80 and 81, thence south on said line between Ranges 80 and 81 to the line between Townships 18 and 19; thence west on said line between Townships 18 and 19 to the Range line between Ranges 81 and 82; thence south on said line between ranges 81 and 82 to the line between Townships 17 and 18; thence east on said township line to the line between ranges 79 and 80; thence south on said line to a point between Townships 16 and 17; thence east on said line between townships 16 and 17 to the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 10. GREEN.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Green Election District No. 10.

Beginning at the south east corner of Township 19, Range 81; thence north on the line between ranges 80 and 81 to the line between townships 20 and 21; thence west along the line between townships 20 and 21 to the line between ranges 83 and 84; thence south on said line between Ranges 83 and 84 to the line between Townships 18 and 19; thence west on said line between Townships 18 and 19 to the line between Ranges 80 and 81 to the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 11. SARATOGA.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Saratoga Election District No. 11.

Beginning at the south east corner of Section 1, Township 16, Range 83 W; thence north on ~~###~~ line between Ranges 82 and 83 to the line between Townships 17 and 18; thence east on said line between Townships 17 and 18 to the line between Ranges 81 and 82; thence north along said line between Ranges 81 and 82 to the line between Townships 18 and 19; thence west along said line between townships 18 and 19 to the line between Ranges 85 and 86; thence south on said line between ranges 85 and 86 to the line between Townships 17 and 18; thence west on said line between townships 17 and 18 to the line between Ranges 87 and 88; thence south on said line between Ranges 87 and 88 to the line between Townships 16 and 17; thence east on said line between Townships 16 and 17 to the line between Ranges 83 and 84; thence south on said line between Ranges 83 and 84 to the southwest corner of Section 6, Township 16, North Range 83 W. the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 12. ENCAMPMENT.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Encampment Election District No. 12.

Beginning at the south east corner of Township 15, N. Range 83 W.; thence north to the southeast corner of Section 1, Township 16, Range 83; thence west to the south west corner of section 6, Township 16, Range 83 W.; thence north to the northeast corner of Township 16, Range 84; thence west to the line between Ranges 85 and 86; thence south on said line between Ranges 85 and 86 to the line between Townships 14 and 15; thence due east to the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 13. BENNETT.

All that territory embraced within the boundaries as follows shall be known as Bennett Election District No. 13.

Commencing on the boundary line between Carbon and Albany Counties and on the line between Townships 14 and 15; thence north on said eastern boundary line of Carbon County to the line between Townships 17 and 18 thence west on said line between Townships 17 and 18 to the line between Ranges 82 and 83; thence south on said line between Ranges 82 and 83 to the line between Townships 14 and 15; thence east on said line between Townships 14 and 15 to the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 14. COLLINS.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Collins Election District No. 14.

Beginning on the boundary line between Carbon and Albany Counties and on the boundary line of the States of Wyoming and Colorado; thence north on the eastern boundary line of Carbon County to the line between Townships 14 and 15 ; thence west on said line between Townships 14 and 15 to the line between Ranges 86 and 87; thence south on said line between Ranges 86 and 87 to the line between Sections 19 and 30 Township 14, N. Range 86W thence east on said line between Sections 19 and 30 to the corner of Sections 19, 20, 29 and 30, Twp. 14. R. 86; thence south on said line between Sections 29 and 30 and 31 and 32, Twp. 14. N. R. 86 W. to the township line between townships 13 and 14; thence east on the said township line between townships 13 and 14 to the line between Ranges 85 and 86; thence south on said range line between Ranges 85 and 86 to the Colorado State Line; thence east along said Colorado State Line to the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 15. SNAKE RIVER.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Snake River Election District No. 15.

Beginning at the point of intersection of the Colorado State Line and the line between Ranges 85 and 86; thence north on said line between Ranges 85 and 86 to the line between townships 13 and 14; thence west on said line between townships 13 and 14 to the Section line between Sections 31 and 32, Township 14, Range 86 W.; thence north on said section line between Sections 31 and 32 and 30 and 29 to Sections corner between Sections 19, 20, 29 and 30, Twp 14. R. 86; thence west on said section line between Sections 19 and 30, Twp. 14. R. 86 to the line between Ranges 86 and 87; thence north on said range line between Ranges 86 and 87 to the line between townships 14 and 15; thence east on the line between townships 14 and 15 to the range line between Ranges 85 and 86; thence north on said range line between ranges 85 and 86 to the line between townships 16 and 17; thence west on said township line between townships 16 and 17 to the range line between Ranges 87 and 88; thence south on said line between ranges 87 and 88 to the line between

townships 15 and 16; thence west on said line between townships 15 and 16 to the dividing line between Carbon and Sweetwater Counties; thence south on said dividing line between Carbon and Sweetwater Counties to the Colorado State Line; thence east along said Colorado State Line to the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 16. SULPHUR.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Sulphur Election District No. 16.

Beginning at the southeast corner of Township 16 on the line between Ranges 87 and 88; thence north on said line between ranges 87 and 88 to the line between Townships 19 and 20; thence west on said line between Townships 19 and 20 to the western boundary line of Carbon County between ranges 93 and 94; thence south on said line between Ranges 93 and 94 to the line between townships 15 and 16; thence east on said line between townships 15 and 16 to the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 17. SAGE CREEK.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Sage Creek Election District No. 17.

All that territory embraced in Townships 19, Range 85, 86 and 87 and in Township 18, Ranges 86 and 87 shall be known as Sage Creek Election District No. 17.

DISTRICT NO. 18.

All that territory embraced within townships 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, N. Range 84 W. shall be known as Walcott Election District No. 18.

✓✓. Rankin Precinct No. 1. shall consist of all that territory embraced is said Election District No. 17.

✓ Election District No. 18 shall consist of One Election Precinct.

✓✓. Walcott Precinct No. 1. shall consist of all that territory embraced within said Election District No. 18.

Be it resolved that there be and there is hereby created a Polling Precinct to be known as Difficulty Precinct No. 5 In Election District No. 4, to conform with the resolution passed at the meeting of the Board held October 5th. 1910 said precinct to be taken from Districts numbers 4 and 5 and embracing Townships 24 and 25 Range 80 and Townships 24 and 25 Range 81.
