

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, SEPTEMBER 7th. 1915.

Board met at 10 o'clock A. M. this 7th day of September A. D. 1915, in regular session as is by law required. Roll call showing present, Commissioners Ivor Christensen, Robert A. Day, Wm. A. Mc Kay, Chairman and L. B. Magor, Clerk.

Proceedings were had as follows, to-wit:-

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

The Board proceeded to make the levy for the requisite taxes upon the assessed and taxable property within the County of Carbon and State of Wyoming for the State, County, City and School revenue for the year A. D. 1915, as is provided by law.

The statement of the State Auditor was presented, read and ordered filed.

The County Assessor submitted the certified statement from the State Auditor of the State of Wyoming, showing the assessment of said County of Carbon, as made by the State Board of Equalization for the year A. D. 1915 and the properties of Corporations, Railroad, Car and Telegraph Lines as hereinafter set forth, and the County Assessor is hereby instructed to add the amounts returned by the State Auditor, to the assessments of said Carbon County for the year A. D. 1915, same being as follows:-

At the meeting of the State Board of Equalization the rate of levy upon each Dollar of valuation for State Revenue for the year A. D., 1915 was fixed at Four Mills (\$.004) and the Board were thereby directed to make this levy as provided by law.

The amount of State Tax charged to Carbon County, Wyoming, for the year A. D. 1915 is \$64,278.82.
