

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, FEBRUARY 8th. 1915.

Board met this 8th day of February A. D. 1915, at 10 o'clock A. M. in Special Session for the purpose of opening bids, as advertised, on the County Poor Farm.

Roll call showing present, Commissioners Robt. A. Day, Ivor Christensen, Wm. A. Mc Kay Chairman and L. B. Magor. Clerk.

Proceedings were had as follows, to-wit:-

Board adjourned to meet at 2 o'clock P. M.

Board met at 2 o'clock P. M. this 8th day of February A. D. 1915, pursuant to adjournment of morning session. Roll call showing all members present.

This being the hour of opening bids on the County Poor Farm the Board proceeded to open the bids on file which were as follows:-

D. C. Jones, Dixon, Wyoming, bid ~~#175.00~~ of 75¢ per day for the care of each inmate.

P. Johnson and Wife, Rawlins, Wyoming, bid ~~#175.00~~ of 75¢ per day for care of each inmate and to pay to Carbon County, Wyoming, the sum of \$150.00 per year for use of farm.

E. J. Colley bid ~~#175.00~~ of 50¢ per day for the board and care of each inmate and to pay to Carbon County, Wyoming, the sum of \$200.00 per year for use of Farm, or 55¢ per day for each inmate without the use of farm and also for the use of the farm alone to pay ton Carbon County, Wyoming, the sum of \$200.00 per year.

Dixon, Wyoming, bid
A. T. & Minnie Shank ~~#175.00~~ 25¢ per meal for each inmate also \$30.00 per month for the necessary care and he to give the County \$360.00 for the use of the Farm per year, or 25¢ per meal and \$50.00 per month without the use of the farm.

W. L. Jones, Dixon, Wyoming, bid ~~#175.00~~ of 75¢ per day for board and care of each inmate and would pay Carbon County, Wyoming, \$300. per year for the use of the Farm.

There being no other bids on motion duly put and carried all bids be laid over for future consideration during the regular meeting.

Board adjourned to meet in regular session on February 3rd. 1915.
