Proceedings were had as follows, to-wit:-

Mr. James Blackhall, Forest Supervisor, came before the Board and presented the application to be signed by the Commissioners for the National Forest Road through the forest from Encampment, Wyoming, to within about one mile north of Slater, Colo. The application was signed and a copy placed on file in the County Clerk's office.

BIDS.

Pursuant to a Call for Bids for the leasing of the County Poor Farm at Dixon, Wyo, and the boarding and caring of the inmates, bids were opened and read as follows:-

Neri Coats, Board and care for inmates for 25¢ per meal for each inmate and the use of the County Farm.

H. W. West. For taking care of the Farm \$90.00 per month and 25¢ per meal for each inmate.

Mrs. and Mr. Peter Johnson. For Boarding and caring of the inmates 25¢ per meal and \$25 per month and they agree to pay \$200.00 per year for the use of the Poor Farm.

Mrs. Fred Johnson. Boarding and caring of the inmates 25¢ per meal and agrees to pay \$200.00 per year for the use of the Farm.

E. J. Colley. Boarding and caring of the inmates 50¢ per day for each inmate and he agrees to pay \$250.00 for the use of the farm per year.

J. A. Colley. Boarding and caring of the inmates 50¢ per day for each inmate and he agrees to pay \$240.00 per year for the use of the farm.

G. W. Cross. First, \$202.50 per year for the use of the Farm and 71¢ per day for the Boarding and care for each inmate.

Second. For the leasing of the Poor Farm \$202.50 per year.

Third. For the Boarding and caring of the inmates, 71¢ per day for each inmate.

D. C. Jones. Agrees to pay \$350.00 per year, for the years 1917 and 1918, for the use of the Poor Farm and if the 16 acres, which were advertised to be sold are sold, then he agrees to pay \$270.00 per year for the use of the farm.

Mrs. Wilda Eversole. For Board and care of the inmates \$15.00 per month for each inmate and she agreeing to pay \$200. per year for the use of the Farm.

All bids were laid over until February 8th. 1917.
