Board met at 2 o'clock P. M. this 7th day of August A. D. 1918, pursuant to adjournment of morning session, Roll call showing all members present.

REPORTS.

Repprts of Justifes of the Peace P. P. Murphy, Jno. C. Friend, Edw. Mc Atee and County Treasurer E. M. Tierney, were read and ordered filed.

Applications for retail liquor licenses were presented for the first reading, as follows:-

A petition was received, signed by a number of voters of the Brown's Hill Country, asking that an Election Precinct be established in that part of the Country for the reason that it is quite a distance from the present nearest voting precinct. The Board considered the matter and decided that they did not deem it advisable to establish a new precinct for the Primary Election but that some action would be taken before the time for the General Election.

A petition was received, sigged by a number of tax-payers of the County, petitioning the Board to establish a public road, as follows, to-wit:-

"Commencing at the County Road as it turns north through Jack Creek Land, at the southwest corner of Section 9, Township 17, N. R. 84 West, thence westerly through the North Half of Section 18, Township 17, North Range 84 West, thence Westerly through the North Half of Section 13, Township 17, North Range 85 West, to the South side of the Northeast quarter (NE 1/4) of the Northeast quarter (NE 1/4) of Section 14, Township 17, North Range 85 West, to the gate of the Jack Creek Land & Cattle Company's Ranch; continuing from the forks of said road east of the Jack Creek Land & Cattle Company's said gate southwesterly to the ranch of Louis Seaverson in Section 31, Township 17, North Range 85 West"

The above road has been traveled by the public for over twenty years but is not recorded as a County Road, and is being obstructed by gates and overflow from irrigation waters through Section 18, Township 17, North Range 84 West, until the same is impassable at times.

A protest was received from Mr. Donald Mc Phail, against the establishment of the above road.

The matter of the establishment of the above described road was considered by the Board and it was deemed advisable to lay the matter over at this time until a thorough examination could be made.

Board adjourned to meet at 10 o'clock A. M. August 8th. 1918.
