- J. A. COLLEY. For furnishing three meals each day for each inmate, 75¢ per day for each inmate and in addition to pay to Carbon County as rental for the County Poor Farm the sum of \$300.00 per year
- MRS. E. J. COLLEY. For Boarding and caring of the inmates \$1.00 per day and agrees to pay to Carbon County the sum of \$250.00 per year as rental for the Farm.
- D. C. JONES. For Boarding and caring ^{of} ~~for~~ the inmates 70¢ per day and agrees to pay to Carbon County the sum of \$350.00 per year, as rental for the County Poor Farm.
