The matter of leasing the County Poor Farm at Dixon, Wyo. pursuant to call for bids heretofore issued, was brought before the Board. The Board after considering all bids filed at the February meeting for the Board and care of the inmates and the leasing of the County Poor Farm for the next two years, and it appearing to the Board that the bid of Mrs. Fred Johnson of 60¢ per day for boarding and caring of each inmate and her offer of \$300.00 per year for rental of the Poor Farm, being the lowest and best bid, it was moved by Commissioner Wood and seconded by Commissioner Rasmussen that Mrs. Fred Johnson be awarded the contract upon her signing an agreement submitted by the County Commissioners, she also to furnish Bond to be approved by the Board.
