Proceedings were had as follows, to-wit:-

ELECTION DISTRICTS.

In compliance with Chapter 146 of the Wyoming Compiled Statutes of 1910, the Board established Election Districts as follows: also Election Precincts in the several Election Districts, to-wit:-

DISTRICT NO. 1. RAWLINS.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Election District No. 1.

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Township 24 N. R. 86 W; running thence west along the township line between townships 24 and 25 to the northwest corner of Twp. 24. N. R. 89 W.; thence south along the west boundary line of Carbon County to the southwest corner of township 20 N. R. 89 W. thence west on the township line between townships 19 and 20 to the range line between ranges 90 and 91; thence south on the range line between Ranges 90 and 91 to the southwest corner of Township 16, N. R. 90 W.; thence east on the township line between townships 15 and 16 to the line between ranges 87 and 88 W.; thence north on the range line between ranges 87 and 88 to the southwest corner of Twp. 18, N. R. 87 W.; thence east on the township line between townships 17 and 18 to the southeast corner of Twp. 18, N. R. 86 W.; thence north on Range line between ranges 85 and 86 to the township line between townships 18 and 19; thence east on said township line to the range line between ranges 84 and 85; thence north on Range line between ranges 84 and 85, to the township line between townships 19 and 20; thence west on the township line between townships 19 and 20 to the range line between ranges 85 and 86; thence north on the Range line between ranges 85 and 86 to the northeast corner of township 24, N. R. 86 W. the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 2. WHISKEY GAP.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Election District No. 2.

Beginning at the southwest corner of Twp. 25. N. R. 89 W. ; thence east on a line between townships 24 and 25 to the North Platte River; thence northwesterly along the North Platte River to the line between Sections 18 and 19, Twp. 27, N. R. 84 W.; thence west along the line between sections 18 and 19 Twp. 27. N. R. 84 W. to the line between ranges 84 and 85; thence north along the line between Ranges 84 and 85 to the North line of Carbon County; thence west along the line between Carbon and Natrona Counties to the line between Carbon and Fremont Counties; thence south along the west line of Carbon County to the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 3. FORT STEELE.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Election District No. 3.

Beginning at the southeast corner of Twp. 20, on a line between Ranges 84 and 85; thence North on said line between Ranges 84 and 85 to the line between townships 24 and 25; thence west along said line between townships 24 and 25 to the line between Ranges 85 and 86; thence south along said line between ranges 85 and 86 to the line between Twps. 19 and 20, thence east along said line to the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 4. LEO.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Election District No. 4.

Beginning at the southeast ^{corner} ~~xxxxxx~~ of Twp. 24. N. R. 80 W.; thence north on Range line between Ranges 79 and 80 to the northeast corner of Twp. 25, N. R. 80 W.; thence west on township line between twps. 25 and 26 to the northwest corner of Twp. 25. N. R. 80 W.; thence North along the line between Ranges 80 and 81 to the north line of Carbon County; thence west along the north line of Carbon County to the line between Ranges 84 and 85 W.; thence south to the line between Sections 18 and 19 Twp. 27. N. R. 84 W.; thence east along the line between sections 18 and 19 Twp. 27. N. R. 84 W. to the North Platte River; thence southeasterly along the line between townships 24 and 25 to the northwest corner of Twp. 24. N. R. 83 W, thence south to the southwest corner of Twp. 24 N. R. 83 W.; thence east along the line between townships 23 and 24 to the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 5. MEDICINE BOW.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Election District No. 5.

All of Twps. 26, 27 and 28, N. R. 80, all of Twps. 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, and 28 Ranges 78 and 79 and all that portion of Townships 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27 and 28, N. R. 77 W. which lies in Carbon County, Wyoming, shall be known as Election District No. 5.

DISTRICT NO. 6. HANNA.

All that territory embraced within Townships 21, 22 and 23, N. Range 81, 82 and 83 W. and also all of Townships 22 and 23 in Range 80, shall be known as Election District No. 6.

DISTRICT NO. 7. ELK MOUNTAIN.

All that territory embraced within Townships 20 and 21 in Ranges 78, 79 and 80 and that portion of townships 20 and 21 N. R. 77 W. of the 6th. P. M. which lies in Carbon County, Wyoming, shall be known as Election District No. 7.

DISTRICT NO. 8. ROCKDALE.

All that territory embraced within Township 18, N. R. 81, all of Townships 18 and 19, N. R. 80, all of Townships 17, 18 and 19, N. Ranges 78 and 79, and all that portion of Townships 17, 18 and 19 N. Range 77 W. of the 6th. P. M. which lies in Carbon County, Wyoming, shall be known as Election District No. 8.

DISTRICT NO. 9. GREEN.

All that territory embraced within Townships 19 and 20, N. Ranges 81, 82 and 83 W. of the 6th. P. M. shall be known as Election District No. 9.

DISTRICT NO. 10. SARATOGA.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Election District No. 10.

Beginning at the southeast corner of Section 1, Twp. 16, N. R. 82 W. of the 6th. P. M.; thence north on the Range line between Ranges 81 and 82 to the township line between Townships 18 and 19, thence west on the township line between townships 18 and 19 to the Range line between Ranges 85 and 86; thence south on the range line between Ranges 85 and 86 to the township line between townships 17 and 18; thence west on the township line between Townships 17 and 18 to the Range Line between Ranges 87 and 88.; thence south on the Range line between Ranges 87 and 88 to the township line between to the township line between townships 16 and 17; thence east on the township line

between townships 16 and 17, to the northeast corner of Twp. 16, N. R. 84 W. thence south on range line between ranges 83 and 84 to the southeast corner of Section 1, Twp. 16, N. R. 84 W. of the 6th. P. M. thence due east to the southeast corner of Sec. 1, Twp. 16, N. R. 84 W. of the 6th. P. M. the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 11. RIVERSIDE.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries, together with that territory embraced within the town of Riverside, Carbon County, Wyoming, shall be known as Election District No. 11.

Beginning at the northeast corner of Sec. 12, Twp. 16, N. R. 83 W. of the 6th. P. M. running thence due west to the southeast corner of Sec. 1, Twp. 16, N. R. 84 W. ; thence north on range line between ranges 83 and 84 to the township line between townships 16 and 17; thence west on township line between townships 16 and 17 to the Range line between ranges 85 and 86. ; thence south on range line between Ranges 85 and 86 to the township line between townships 15 and 14; thence east on the township line between townships 14 and 15 to the range line between Ranges 82 and 83; thence north on the Range line between Ranges 82 and 83 to the northeast corner of Section 12, Twp. 16, N. R. 83 W. of the 6th. P. M. the place of beginning, also including all that territory embraced within the corporate limits of the Town of Riverside, Carbon County, Wyoming.

DISTRICT NO. 12. BENNETT.

All that territory embraced within townships 15, 16, and 17, in Ranges 80 and 81, all of Township 15, N. Range 82, and all of Township 16, N. Range 82 W. of the 6th. P. M. save and except all of Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 in Twp. 16, N. R. 82 W. of the 6th. P. M. shall be known as Election District No. 12.

DISTRICT NO. 13. ENCAMPMENT.

All that territory embraced within Townships 13 and 14, N. Ranges 80, 81, 82, 83, 84 and 85, all that portion of Township 12, N. Ranges 80, 81, 82, 83, 84 and 85, which lies in Carbon County, Wyoming, and all of Township 14, N. R. 86 W. of the 6th. P. M. shall be known as Election District No. 13; save and except that portion which lies within the corporate limits of the Town of Riverside, Carbon County, Wyoming.

DISTRICT NO. 14. SNAKE RIVER.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Election District No. 14.

Beginning at the northeast corner of Twp. 16, N. R. 86 W. running thence ^{west} on the township line between townships 16 and 17 to the range line between Ranges 87 and 88 W. thence south on the range line between Ranges 87 and 88 to the township line between townships 15 and 16; thence west on the township line between townships 15 and 16, to the west line of Carbon County, Wyoming; running thence south on the west line of Carbon County, Wyoming, to the line between Colorado and Wyoming, thence east on the Colorado State Line to the range line between Ranges 85 and 86; thence north on the range line between Ranges 85 and 86 to the township line between townships 13 and 14; thence west on the township line between townships 13 and 14 to the Range line between Ranges 86 and 87; thence north on the Range Line between Ranges 86 and 87 to the township line between Townships 14 and 15; thence east on the township line between townships 14 and 15 to the Range line between Ranges 85 and 86; thence north on the Range line between Ranges 85 and 86 to the northeast corner of Twp. 16, N. R. 86 W. of the 6th. P. M. the place of beginning.

DISTRICT NO. 15. DAD.

DISTRICT NO. 15. DAD.

All that territory embraced within Townships 16, 17, 18 and 19, N. Ranges 91, 92 and 93 W. of the 6th. P. M. shall be known as Election District No. 15.

DISTRICT NO. 16. WALCOTT.

All that territory embraced within Townships 19, 20, 21, 22, 23 and 24, N. R. 84 W. of the 6th. P. M. shall be known as Election District No. 16.

Election District No. 1 shall consist of three election precincts.

RAWLINS PRECINCT NO. 1, shall consist of all that portion of the City of Rawlins, lying south of Lincoln Highway Street in the City of Rawlins, also all that territory outside of the corporate limits of said City of Rawlins, lying south of the Union Pacific Railroad track in said Election District No. 1.

RAWLINS PRECINCT NO. 2, shall consist of all that portion of the City of Rawlins, lying north of Lincoln Highway Street and west of Fifth Street in said City of Rawlins.

RAWLINS PRECINCT NO. 3, shall consist of all that portion of the City of Rawlins, lying north of Lincoln Highway Street and east of Fifth Street in said City of Rawlins, also all that territory outside of the corporate limits of said City of Rawlins, lying north of the Union Pacific Railroad Track in said Election District No. 1.

Election District No. 2, shall consist of two election precincts.

WHISKEY GAP PRECINCT NO. 1, shall consist of all that territory embraced within townships 26, 27 and 28, N. Range 87 and all of Townships 25, 26, 27 and 28 N. Ranges 88 and 89 W. of the 6th. P. M.

OIL CAMP PRECINCT NO. 2, shall consist of all that territory embraced within Election District No. 2, which is not included in Whiskey Gap Precinct No. 1.

Election District No. 3 shall consist of one election precinct.

FORT STEELE PRECINCT NO. 1, shall consist of all that territory embraced within Election District No. 3.

Election District No. 4, shall consist of five election precincts.

LEO PRECINCT NO. 1, shall consist of all that territory embraced within Townships 24, Ranges 82 and 83 and all of Townships 25, Range 82 and 83 and that portion of Range 84 lying east of the North Platte River in Township 25.

COWDIN PRECINCT NO. 3, shall consist of all that territory embraced within Townships 26, Range 82, and all of Township 26 in Range 83 and that part of Twp/ 26, Range 84 W. lying east of the North Platte River.

SHIRLEY PRECINCT NO. 2, shall consist of all that territory embraced within Township 26, Range 81 and Townships 27 and 28 in Ranges 81 and 82 W.

PEDRO PRECINCT NO. 4, shall consist of all that territory embraced in Townships 27 and 28 in Ranges 83 and 84, except that part of township 27 Range 84 W. lying west of the North Platte River.

DIFFICULTY PRECINCT NO. 5, shall consist of all that territory embraced within Townships 24 and 25, Ranges 80 and 81 W. of the 6th. P. M.

Election District No. 5, shall consist of one election precinct.

MEDICINE BOW PRECINCT NO. 1, shall consist of all that territory embraced within Election District No. 5.

Election District No. 6, shall consist of two election precincts.

HANNA PRECINCT NO. 1, shall consist of all that territory embraced within said Election District No. 6, except Sections 15, 16, 21 and 22, in Twp. 22. N. R. 81 W.

ELMO PRECINCT NO. 2, shall consist of all that territory embraced within Secs. 15, 16, 21 and 22 in Twp. 22. N. R. 81 W. of the 6th. P. M.

Election District No. 7, shall consist of one election precinct.

ELK MOUNTAIN PRECINCT NO. 1, shall consist of all that territory embraced within Election District No. 7.

Election District No. 8, shall consist of three election precincts.

ROCKDALE PRECINCT NO. 1, shall consist of all that territory embraced within Townships 19; Ranges 77; 78; and 79, in said Election District No. 8;

MORGAN PRECINCT NO. 2, shall consist of all that territory embraced within Townships 17 and 18 Ranges 77; 78 and 79 in said Election District No. 8.

WIDDOFIELD PRECINCT NO. 3, shall consist of all that territory embraced within Townships 18 and 19, Ranges ~~77, 78 and 79~~ 80, and Township 18 N. R. 81 in said election district No. 8.

Election District No. 9 shall consist of one election precinct.

GREEN PRECINCT NO. 1, shall consist of all that territory embraced within Election District No. 9.

Election District No. 10, shall consist of one election precinct.

SARATOGA PRECINCT NO. 1, shall consist of all that territory embraced within Election District No. 10.

Election District No. 11, shall consist of three election precincts.

COW CREEK PRECINCT NO. 1, shall consist of all that territory embraced within said Election District No. 11, divided by Cow Creek and Calf Creek, except that divided by Calf Creek.

SPRING CREEK PRECINCT NO. 2, shall consist of all that territory embraced within said Election District No. 11; divided by Spring Creek and Calf Creek, except that part embraced within Riverside Precinct No. 3.

RIVERSIDE PRECINCT NO. 3, shall consist of all that territory embraced within Township 15, N. R. 83 W. and also the Town of Riverside in Sec. 1, Twp. 14. N. R. 84 W. except Sections 5, 6 and 7 in Twp. 15. N. R. 83 W.

Election District No. 12, shall consist of two election precincts.

BENNETT PRECINCT NO. 1, shall consist of all that territory embraced within the West Half of Twp. 15. N. R. 82 W. all of Twp. 16, N. R. 82 W. except Secs. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6, in said township, also all of Townships 16 and 17, N. Ranges 80 and 81 W.

FRENCH PRECINCT NO. 2, shall consist of all that territory embraced within the East Half of Twp. 15. N. R. 82 W. and all of Twp. 15, N. R. 80 and 81 in said Election District No. 12.

Election District No. 13, shall consist of three election precincts.

COLLINS PRECINCT NO. 1, shall consist of all that territory embraced within Townships 12, 13 and 14 in Ranges 82 and 83.

ENCAMPMENT PRECINCT NO. 2, shall consist of all that territory embraced within Township 14, N. R. 86 W. also all of Twps. 12, 13 and 14, in Ranges 84 and 85, in said Election District No. 13, save and except that certain territory contained in Riverside Precinct.

BIG CREEK PRECINCT NO. 3, shall consist of all that territory embraced within all that portion of Election District No. 13, in Townships 12, 13 and 14, Ranges 80 and 81 W.

Election District No. 14, shall consist of five election precincts.

SAVERY PRECINCT NO. 1, shall consist of all that territory embraced within said Election District No. 14, in Twps 12, 13, 14, 15 and 16, Ranges 86, 87, 88 and 89, except that

portion embraced within the precinct of Brown's Hill No. 5.

DIXON PRECINCT NO. 2, shall consist of all that territory embraced within Townships 12, 13, 14 and 15, Range 90 W. in said Election District No. 14, save and except Sections 1, 2, 11, 12, 13, 14, 23, 24, 25, 26, 35 and 36 in Twps. 14 and 15, Range 90 W.

BAGGS PRECINCT NO. 3, shall consist of all that territory embraced within Townships 12, 13, 14, and 15, Ranges 91 and 92 W. in said Election District No. 14.
