

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS. SEPTEMBER. 7th. 1920.

Board met at 10 o'clock A. M. this 7th. day of September A. D. 1920; in Special session for the purpose of making the levy for the requisite taxes upon the assessed and taxable property within the County for the year A. D. 1920.

Roll call showing present, Commissioners A. W. Rasmussen and R. T. Wood and R. A. Magor, Clerk, Chairman Wm. A. Mc Kay, absent, In the absence of Chairman Mc Kay, Commissioner A. W. Rasmussen was chosen Chairman Pro Tem.

Proceedings were had as follows, to-wit:-

The Board proceeded to make the levy for the requisite taxes upon the assessed and taxable property withi the County of Carbon, State of Wyoming, for the State, County, City and School Revenue for the year A. D. 1920, as is provided by law.

The statement of the State Board of Equalization was presented, read and ordered filed.

The County Assessor submitted the certified statement from the State Board of Equalization of the State of Wyoming, showing the assessment of said County of Carbon, ~~and~~ as made by the State Board of Equalization for the year A. D. 1920, and the properties of Corporations, Railroad, Car and Telegraph Lines as herein after set forth, and the County Assessor is hereby instructed to add the amounts returned by the State Board of Equalization, to the assessments of Carbon County for the year A. D. 1920, the same being a total as follows:-

At the meeting of the State Board of Equalization the rate of levy upon each Dollar of Valuation for State Purposes for the year A. D. 1920, was fixed at Three and Ninety-eight hundredths Mills (\$.00398) and the Board was thereby directed to make this levy as provided by law.

The amount of State Tax charged to Carbon County, Wyoming, for the year A D. 1920, is \$ 103,396.29
