Proceedings were had as follows, to-wit:-

Poll and Road Tax.

Regarding the matter of the collection of Poll and Road Taxes by the Assessor at the time of assessment, it was regularly moved by Commissioner Nelson and seconded by Commissioner McKay, that all persons between the age of Twenty-one and Fifty years, inclusive, pay a Poll Tax of Two (\$2.00) Dollars for School Purposes in accordance with Section 2320 of the Wyoming Compiled Statutes of 1910, and also that each able-bodied man in the County Between the age of Twenty-one and Fifty years, inclusive, pay a special Road Tax of Two (\$2.00) Dollars according to Section 2562 of the Wyoming Compiled Statutes of 1910. Motion Carried.

The Matter of estimating the cost of maintaining the County Government for the year, 1921 in compliance with Section 1132 of the Compiled Statutes of Wyoming, 1910, was considered and after due calculations apportionment was made as follows:-to-wit:-

General Fund-----	\$56,000.00
Road & Bridge-Fund-----	\$40,000.00
Poor & Pauper-Fund-----	\$10,000.00
District Court Fund-----	\$ 4,000.00
Total	\$110,000.00
