Proceedings were had as follows, to-wit:-

The Minutes of the previous session were read and approved. *Road*

The Clerk was instructed to advertise the location and Establishment of a County Road East of Medicine Bow, Wyoming, more particularly described by the Surveyor's Field Notes, as follows, to-wit:

COUNTY ROAD EAST OF MEDICINE BOW, WYOMING.

Beginning at the North Quarter Corner of Section 11, T. 22. N. R. 78 W. of ~~Sixth~~ 6th P. M.;

Thence West along section lines between sections 2 and 11, and 3 and 10, to a point 420 feet east of the Quarter corner between sections 3 and 10;

Thence S. 68°-00' W. 453 feet to the north and south center line of section 10; Thence south along the north and south center line of said Sec. 10, 870 feet to old U. P. Grade;

Thence along old U. P. Grade as follows:

N. 88°-30' W. 670 feet;

S. 80°-30' W. 900 feet;

S. 80°-00' W. 2550 feet;

S. 89°-15' W. 2260 feet to a point on the Lincoln Highway which point bears N. 58°- 00' E. 1930 feet from the West quarter corner of section 9, T. 22 N. R. 78 W. of the 6th P. M.
