

Board of County Commissioners reconvened this 3rd day of September with all members present and D. West presiding.

Extensions having become necessary to the highways in the northern part of the county, by motion regularly made and carried, the board advised the clerk to advertise for condemnation proceedings the following description of the proposed highway in three successive issues of the official paper of Carbon County:
