By motion duly made and carried Frank Ritter was allowed County Aid in the amount of \$10.00 a month.

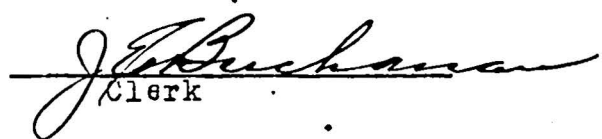
