

## SPECIAL MEETING

June 13, 1927

The Board met in special session this 13th day of June A. D. 1927, at 10 O'clock A. M. There being present I. K. Miller Chairman and Frank Schilt second member of the Board.

By resolution offered by Frank Schilt seconded by I. K. Miller and duly carried the following road location notices were ordered spread on the minutes of this Board.

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RE-LOCATION AND ESTABLISHMENT OF LINCOLN HIGHWAY  
BETWEEN RAWLINS AND SWEETWATER COUNTY LINE.

Office of the County Clerk, Carbon County, Wyoming, June 14, 1927.

Notice of proposed re-location and establishment of Lincoln Highway between Rawlins and Sweetwater County line.

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

You and each of you are hereby notified that the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, has decided to relocate and establish a right-of-way for the Lincoln Highway from the Sweetwater County Line to Rawlins, Wyoming.

Being a description of a parcel of land of a total width of 100 feet being 50 feet on either side of and equi-distant from a center line described as follows:

Beginning at a point which is on the line between Carbon County and Sweetwater County which is identical with the lines between Sections 25 Twp. 21, Range 90 and Section 30, Twp. 21 Range 89, which point is 2438.4 feet south of Northwest Corner of Sec. 30, Twp. 21, Rg. 89 West of the 6th P. M., and proceeding in a generally north-easterly direction thru Sections 30 and 29, and the  $S\frac{1}{2}$  of the  $E\frac{1}{2}$  of Sec. 20, to station 4200 located in the SE of SE Sec. 20, Twp. 21, Rg. 89. Proceeding thence thru said Sec. 20 and 21, 22 to Station marked 4312 in the NE of NE of Sec. 22, which portion of right-of-way between Station 4200 and 4312 shall be 150 feet wide 50 feet being South of center line and 100 feet north of center line. Resuming the description of the 100 foot right-of-way and proceeding in a NE direction to the intersection of Sec. 14 and 15 and 22 and 23. Proceeding thence thru Sec. 14 and 13 in an easterly direction to the quarter Section line of Sec. 14, thence in northeast direction thru Sec. 13 all in Twp. 21 North Rg. 89 West.

Thence in southeasterly direction thru Section 18 Twp. 21 Rg. 89 West and Sections 19, 20, 21, easterly thru Section 22 and 23, thence northeasterly thru sections 24, all in Twp. 21 Rg. 88. Proceeding in a northeasterly direction thru the NW and NE of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 19, thence thru the SE of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 18 and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 18 all in Twp. 21 Rg. 87 West 6th P. M., to a point on the lines between Sections 17 and 18 Twp. 21 Rg. 87 West 6th P. M. Whence the SE corner of said Section 18 bears South 1221.4 feet being the end of said project.

All persons owning land or claiming any interest in any lands herein described over or across which said proposed road will pass and who have any objections to the location laying out and establishment of said proposed road as herein described or who have any claims or damages for such location laying out and establishment of

the proposed road are hereby notified that all such objections or claims for damages must be filed in writing with the County Clerk of Carbon County, Wyoming, at Rawlins, on or before 12:00 o'clock Noon on July 15th A. D. 1927, or such objections or claims for damages will be forever barred.

The above description is in conformity with the field notes and blueprint of said road on file in this office.

NOTICE OF PROPOSED LOCATION AND ESTABLISHMENT OF HIGHWAY BETWEEN ENCAMPMENT WEST TO THE FOREST BOUNDARY THRU THE NEISWINDER RANCH.

Office of the County Clerk, Carbon County, Wyoming, June 14, 1927,

Notice of proposed location and establishment of highway between Encampment west to the Forest boundary thru the Neiswinder ranch.

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

You and each of you are hereby notified that the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming has decided to relocate and establish a right-of-way for a road between Encampment west thru the Neiswinder Ranch to the Forest Boundary.

Being a description of a parcel of land of a total width of 80 feet being 40 feet equi-distant from the center line and shall comprise 14.57 acres.


Beginning at a point 660 ft. S. of the 1/16th corner, which corner is the N. E. corner of the N. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the N. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 10, T. 14 N. R. 84 W.; said point being Engineer's Station 108 plus 08.0 thence along the arc of a 4 degree curve left 361.0 ft. to Engr's sta. 11 plus 69.0 P. T. of said 4 degree curve; thence S. 57 $\frac{1}{2}$  deg. 27 min. W. 2628.1 ft. to Eng'r' sta. 137 plus 97.1 P. C. ; thence along the arc of a 4 degree curve to the right 478.4 ft. to Eng'r's sta. 142 plus 75.5 P. T. of said 4 degree curve right; thence S. 76 deg. 35 min. W. 767.3 ft to Eng'r's sta. 150 plus 42.8 P. C. ; thence along the arc of a 10 degree C. L. 381.0 ft. to Eng'r's Sta. 154 plus 23.8 P. T. of said 10 degree C. L.; thence S. 38 deg. 29 min. W. 1248.0 ft to Eng'r's Sta. 166 plus 71.8 P. C.; thence along the arc of a 4 degree C. L. 235.8 ft. to Eng'r's Sta. 169 plus 07.6 P. T. of said 4 degree C. L.; thence S. 29 deg. 03 min. W. 912.2 ft. to Eng'r's Sta. 178 plus 19.8 P. C. thence along the arc of a 10 degree C. R. 437.7 ft. to Eng'r's Sta. 182 plus 57.5 P. T. of said 10 degree C. R.; thence S. 72 deg. 49 min. W. 196.8 ft. to Eng'r's Sta. 184 plus 54.3 P. C.; thence along the arc of a 10 degree C. L. 285.7 ft. to Eng'r's Sta. 187 plus 40.0 a point on said 10 degree C. L. which is on the mid-section line between sections 9 and 16, and lies 476 ft. E. of Sec. corner common to sections 8, 9, 16 and 17, T. 14 N. R. 84 W. Total length 7932 ft.
