By motion duly made and carried R. H. Hopkins was nominated to succeed himself as Trustee for the Carbon County Memorial Hospital .

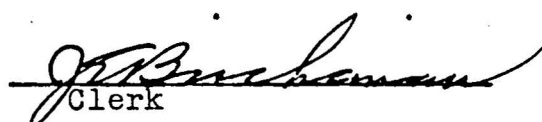
