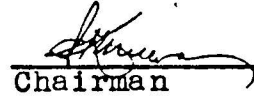
COMMISSIONERS DEED

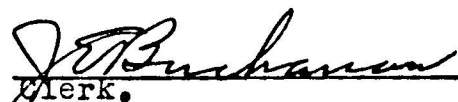
