RESOLUTION

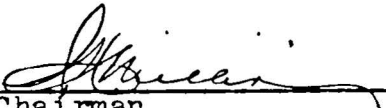
Coal WHEREAS; A large part of the County are strongly in favor of a change in the Lincoln Highway extending from Medicine Bow on the North Side of the Track thru Hanna and thence across the U. P. R. R. to the Lincoln Highway at the Andy Nelson ranch; The State Highway Department
And WHEREAS, Has by resolution intimated that at some future time such change will *probably* be made.

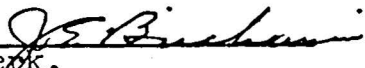
THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That this Board strongly endorse the Resolution of the State Highway Department concerning this change and also urge that the Department would hasten the completion of this project as early as possible.

The Text of the Highway Commission Resolution is as follows:

"RESOLVED: That no further construction of a permanent nature be done on the route between Nelsons ranch and Medicine Bow U. S. No. 30 until final decision as to proper location can be made: Further, That the route from or near Nelsons ranch, across the Union Pacific and thru Hanna on the North side of the Union Pacific to Medicine Bow shall be adopted unless the facts appear to establish some other route as preferable, in which case the people of Hanna and others interested shall be notified and given opportunity to appear before the Commissioners."

There being nothing further before the Board at this time it was duly adjourned to met on Tuesday November 5th A. D. 1929 at 10 O'clock A. M.
