

COMMISSIONER'S MEETING OCTOBER 5th A. D. 1926.

The Board of County Commissioner's met this 5th day of October 1926, at 10 O'clock A. M. Mr. W. M. Englehart being absent.

A delegation headed by Gordon Morgan, James Sowder and others from the Platte Valley presented a Petition at this time which was largely signed by the residents of that district requesting the construction of a steel bridge over the Platte river at or near the Day Ranch to connect up the east side of the River with the Railroad and the Rocky Mountain Highway.
