ROAD PETITIONS:

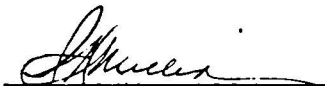
One road petition presented by citizens of Brown's Hill and another from the Citizens of Savery requesting improvement of roads in their respective districts. Taken under advisement.
