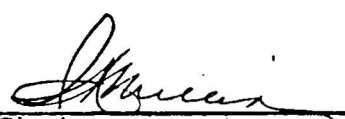
ORCHARD DITCH SUIT

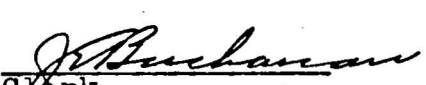
