FEBRUARY 11th, 1930.




The object of this session being to pass on the Bids made for the construction of the Butler Bridge. The Board proceeded to open the Bids as advertised.

Two Bids only were presented at this time. One from Chris O'Neil of Platteville, Colo. for \$11,920.00 and the other by Swenson Lumber Company of Laramie, Wyoming for \$13,000.00.

Chris O'Neil's Bid being the less of the two on motion by Frank Schilt seconded by I. K. Miller and regularly carried the Board accepted this Bid and directed the County Attorney to draw up a contract covering the same.

There being nothing further before the Board at this time it was regularly adjourned to meet in regular session on March 4th A. D. 1930 at 10 o'clock A. M.
