The Board recessed to meet the following day June 4th at the hour of 10 A. M.

The Board resumed its session this 4th day of June A. D. 1931 and proceeded with the following business.

Motion made by Kinnaman, seconded by Penland, carried unanimously that the following resolution be adopted :

Whereas the University of Wyoming, through its Department of State Experiment Farms, proposes to enter into formal contract for the purchase of the necessary trees and shrubs required by the various municipalities in the State of Wyoming for the planting of municipal nurseries, so that the material can thereafter be utilized in the creation of George Washington Memorial Parks in each of the municipalities in this state and

Whereas assurance has been received that the Commissioners of this county can acquire some of such nursery material for planting in a county nursery, with the intent to utilize such material when properly grown, for planting around county property and/or school houses within the county in the rural districts and

Whereas the cost of such material will be the sum of \$150.00 per nursery unit, as said unit is defined in the letter of April 29, 1931, addressed by George E. Brimmer as Chairman to the members of the Wyoming Commission for the Celebration of the Two Hundredth Anniversary of the Birth of George Washington.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that this county order from the Department of State Experiment Farms of the University of Wyoming, 1 unit of nursery stock as heretofore defined, for planting in a county nursery to be established in this county and that the chairman and clerk of the board of county commissioners be authorized and directed to execute such order and

Be it further resolved that a warrant made payable to the University of Wyoming as trustee be forwarded with said order for the sum necessary to cover the purchase price of said unit of nursery stock at the rate of \$150.00 per unit and that the necessary officers of this county be authorized and directed to execute and pay such warrant.

J. C. Martinez was awarded the contract, being lowest bidder, for wiring of County Fair Building according to specified plans. Amount of bid \$700.00
