DISTRICT NO. ONE

Beginning at a point on Section line between Section² 19 and 20 and proceeding in a Northeast direction paralleling the Railroad to the Junction of seventh street and front street, thence running north on seventh street to Buffalo Street, thence northeast on Buffalo Street to section line between Section 15 and 16, thence south to section line between section 21 and 28, thence west to Southwest corner of Section 20, thence north to point of beginning all in Township 21 Range 87.

Precinct No 1 District No. 1

Precinct No. 1 District No. 2

Beginning at intersection of Second and Buffalo Streets thence east on Buffalo Street to a point on section line between Sections 15 and 16; thence North to Northeast corner of Section 16; thence west to a point between Sections 8 and 17; thence South on Second street to a point of beginning.

Precinct No. 2 District No. 2

Precinct No. 2 District No. 3

Beginning ^{at} ~~in~~ the West ^{end of} ~~on~~ Lincoln Highway thence east to Tenth Street; thence north to the alley between Walnut and Maple Streets; thence east to the Lot Line between Lots 3 and 4 Block 54, U. P. 5th Addition to Rawlins; thence north to Walnut Street; thence east to seventh Street; thence north to point on section line between Section 8 and 17; thence west to northwest corner of Section 17; thence south to point of beginning. *over*

DISTRICT NO. 4, WHISKEY GAP.

All that territory embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as Election District No. 4.
