The Board of County Commissioners met this 18th day of October, 1933, in Special Session with all members present, Frank Schilt in the chair.

After discussing County business the Board introduced, passed and adopted the following Resolutions:

On motion of Glenn Penland, seconded by Dan Kinneman and duly carried a Resolution was introduced, passed and adopted that Frank Schilt, Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, be authorized to sign said Agreement between Carbon County and State Highway Department pertaining to the maintenance of 13.2 miles of road, Cb-9 NRS-259, Subdivision to Maintain Highways Improved Under the National Industrial Recovery Act.
