Mr. Daugherty and Mr. Morgan, members of the School Board of District No. 15 made a report to the Commissioners, of the special Board meeting of District No. 15, whereby District No. 15 agreed to take care of the isolated pupils in their district and upon motion of Dan Kinnaman, seconded by Glen Penland and carried, it was decided that the boundary board would take no further action in regard to the petitions, to change the boundary line of District No. 15.

A large delegation consisting of taxpayers of Hanna and Elk Mountain, and including the Woman's Club of Elk Mountain met with the Board at this time in regard to the construction of the Hanna-Elk Mountain road. This matter was taken up at once with James B. True, superintendent of State Highway Department as to whether any State or Federal funds were available to help construct a new road. The delegation was advised that they would be informed later of the action taken in this matter by Mr. True and the delegation was also assured by the Board of County Commissioners that everything possible would be done to maintain the old road.

The Board was offered a bid of \$150.00 for Lots 1, 2, 3 Block 7, South Park Addition to Rawlins, by L. E. Armstrong. Said bid was rejected by the Board.
