Abandonment of Road

On motion of the Board duly made and carried it was decided to abandon and close a portion of Old-Riverside State Line road and acting in compliance with Sec. 52-216 Wyo. Compiled Statutes of 1931, said Board authorized the publication of the following notice:

Portion of Old Riverside - State Line Road to be abandoned (replaced by new State Highway.)

The County Commissioners have decided to abandon and close that portion of the present county road running southeasterly through Section 35, T. 15 N., R. 83 W.; Sections 2, 1 and 12, T. 14 N., R. 83 W.; Sections 7 and 8, T. 14 N., R. 82 W., on the following described center-line:

Beginning at a point on the south edge of the right-of-way of the new Riverside - State Line Highway in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 35, T. 15 N., R. 83 W., located N. 79° 25' W. 1237 feet from the southeast corner of said Section 35;

thence S. 34° 25' E. 1096 feet;

thence S. 29° 30' E. 6410 feet;

thence S. 2° 51' E. 300 feet;

thence S. 46° 13' E. 1050 feet;

thence S. 75° 02' E. 281 feet;

thence N. 72° 35' E. 500 feet;

thence N. 67° 55' E. 480 feet;

thence S. 65° 32' E. 815 feet; to a point located North 530 feet from the east quarter-corner of Section 12, T. 14 N., R. 83 W.;

thence S. 65° 32' E. 5770 feet;

thence S. 58° 20' E. 413 feet;

thence S. 62° 30' E. 852 feet, to a point on the south edge of the right-of-way of the new Riverside - State Line Highway in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, T. 14 N., R. 82 W., located N. 80° 33' E. 1121 feet from the southwest corner of said Section 8.

The above right-of-way is 80 feet in width, being 40 feet on each side of the above described center-line; the total length to be abandoned is 3.403 miles.
