Petition for Road.

✓ Road The Petition of certain residents of Carbon County, State of Wyoming, for the establishment of a public road, sometimes called the Riverside-State Line Road, commencing at a point 316 feet South of the Township corner, common to Townships Numbered Fourteen (14) and Fifteen (15) North, Range Eighty-three (83), West of the 6th P. M., and Townships Numbered Fourteen (14) and Fifteen (15) North Range Eighty-four (84), West of the 6th P.M., the course thereof being generally in an east and southerly direction to a point of intersection with the Colorado-Wyoming State Line, said point of intersection being on the south boundary line of Section Numbered Twenty (20), Township Numbered Twelve (12) North, Range Eighty (80), West of the 6th P.M., Wyoming, being located South 38° 41' East, 1901.7 feet from the closing corner of the Colorado Survey on the South line of said Section Numbered Twenty (20), having been filed in the office of the County Clerk and Ex-Officio Register of Deeds of Carbon County, Wyoming, at Rawlins, on February 13, 1934, and a list having been filed on the same date with

said Petition purporting to contain the names and known Post Office addresses of each person owning or interested in the land across which the establishment of said proposed road is requested, was brought up for consideration and discussion.

After due consideration thereof, it was determined by said Board that said Petition was in proper form, executed by more than ten (10) electors of Carbon County, Wyoming, residing within fifteen (15) miles of the proposed road, and that the list filed with said Petition contained the names and known Post Office addresses of each person owning or interested in the land traversed by said proposed road.

It was then moved by D. C. Kinnaman and seconded by Glenn Penland, that L. E. Vivion, a disinterested elector of Rawlins, Carbon County, Wyoming, be appointed Viewer of the proposed road to examine the expediency thereof, and to report immediately as by law required.

Meeting adjourned until Thursday, March 8th, at 10:00 o'clock A. M.

Commissioners' Deed.

On motion duly made and carried the Clerk was requested to prepare a Commissioners' Deed in favor of J. B. Quigley of Rawlins, covering Lots 26-27, Block 21, Park Hill Addition and upon the receipt of Twenty Dollars, (\$20.00) said Deed was delivered to the purchaser.

Agreement.

An Agreement between Frank O. Anderson and Oscar N. Johnson of Saratoga, and the Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, pertaining to the taking down of the Old Fort, Steele Bridge and removing same to "Pick Road Crossing.", together with BOND FOR PERFORMANCE OF CONTRACT were approved and filed with the clerk.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time it was regularly moved, seconded and carried that the meeting adjourn until Tuesday, April 3rd, 1934.
