A delegation from Encampment and Riverside met with the Board in regard to construction or maintenance of a portion of the road from Riverside to the State Line whereupon the Board agreed to give this matter its early attention.

A large delegation from Savery and vicinity petitioned the Board for the reconstruction of the road from one fourth of a mile east of the Reader Cemetery, continuing down the river to or near the old Dolan Ranch, approximately five miles and from the Dolan Ranch to Dixon. Matter was taken under advisement.

A meeting with the Boundary Board and School Board of District No. 15 was held at this time to discuss the matter pertaining to some of the isolated pupils in District No. 15. No action was taken.
