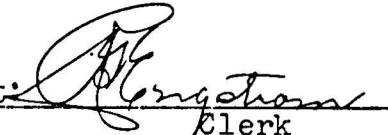
Mrs. A. J. Rosier was unanimously re-appointed as member of County Library Board.
