

## COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS

The Board of County Commissioners met this 5th day of December, A. D. 1939, all members present, with Fred F. Hansen presiding.

Hearing was held on application of Samuel B. Bailey for liquor license. Attorney D. R. Higley presented a protest to the Board of County Commissioners, signed by several Rawlins business men. This hearing was postponed until December 28, 1939, at the request of Attorney, George R. Parsons, to be held at 10:00 A. M. on said date.

On motion duly made and seconded and unanimously carried, call for bids for County House equipment will be held as follows:

CALL FOR BIDS

Sealed proposals for the furnishing of equipment for the Carbon County Courthouse and Jail Building for the County of Carbon at Rawlins, Wyoming, will be received in the auditorium of the Central School Building, adjacent to the present County Offices, Rawlins, Wyoming, until 2 o'clock P.M., Thursday, January 4, 1940, and then will be publicly opened and read.

All bids shall be made on the printed forms attached to and made a part of the proposed contract documents. The contract documents may be examined at the office of the County Clerk at Rawlins, Wyoming, or the consulting architect, Frederic Hutchinson Porter, 211 West 19 Street, Cheyenne, Wyoming, from whom the said contract documents may also be obtained on deposit of the sum of ten dollars (\$10.00). This deposit will be refunded to each actual bidder upon return of the contract documents in good condition within a reasonable time after the receipt of bids.

Each bidder must submit with his bid a certified check in an amount equal to ten (10) per cent of his bid, and the check of the successful bidder or bidders shall be retained by the Owner until delivery of material is completed.

No bidder may withdraw his bid for at least thirty days after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids.

Preference, as required by State law, is hereby given to materials, supplies and provisions produced, manufactured or grown in Wyoming, quality being equal to articles offered by competitors outside of the State.

The Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County reserve the right to reject any or all bids and the waive informalities.

It was regularly moved and seconded that agreement with State Highway Department, covering the survey of seven miles of the Savery-Deep Gulch Road, be accepted and the Chairman of the Board and the County Clerk be authorized to sign the agreement, and that whatever funds are necessary to pay the cost of the County's share, are hereby authorized for appropriation.

It was regularly moved and seconded and carried unanimously that the following resolution be adopted:

WHEREAS, THE STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT has submitted to the Public Roads Administration a certain secondary project, known as F.A.S. 14-A, Section of the Saratoga-Brush Creek Road, and

WHEREAS, This project, not being on the State Highway system, the State Highway Department cannot bear any of the expense for right of way on the project, and

WHEREAS, construction of said highway is of a benefit to Carbon County.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Board of County Commissioners will obtain, without cost to the State, all right of way required for the construction of said highway, and hereby guarantee to save the State harmless from any right of way damages due to the construction of said highway; and be it further resolved

That there is authorized to be appropriated whatever funds are necessary to pay for any right of way damages due to the construction of said project.
