

SPECIAL MEETING

The Board of County Commissioners met this 24th day of March A. D. 1939, at 9:30 A.M., in special session with all commissioners present, Fred F. Hansen presiding.

The purpose of the meeting was to consider an amendatory application for PWA Project Wyoming 1083-F, and a resolution was introduced by Commissioner Gooldy, seconded by Commissioner McCarthy for the admission of an amendatory application and was unanimously carried.

A revised resolution awarding contract was introduced by Commissioner Gooldy, seconded by Commissioner McCarthy and unanimously carried.

Frederic H. Porter, architect, appeared before the Board and advised them of the conditions of the finances in the revised estimate of cost and discussed the plans and specifications with the Board and official correspondent.

The appointment of Dr. Harry Irwin for Deputy health officer for Saratoga was confirmed by the Board.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned until next regular session April 4th, 1939.
