The monthly reports of County officers were read and approved and placed on file.

Thereupon the Board adjourned until March 7, 1940.

The Board resumed its session this 7 day of March, 1940, all members present, Fred F. Hansen, Chairman.

J. E. Tierney, Ed. A. Smyth and J. W. Alexander met with the Board to discuss office space in the new building for Carbon County Welfare Department.

On motion by Commissioner Gooldy and second by McCarthy, Ed. Robertson was appointed Custodian of the Courthouse and Jail Building, and Louis Medina was appointed assistant Custodian.


Thereupon the Board adjourned until March 8, 1940.
