REGULAR MEETING

The Board of County Commissioners met April 2, 1940, at 10:00 o'clock A.M., all members present, Fred F. Hansen presiding.

The minutes of special meetings held March 15 and March 20, 1940 were read and approved.

There being no protest to liquor license application of Robinson & O'Donnell of Lamont, Wyoming, motion was made by Commissioner McCarthy and seconded by Commissioner Gooldy that retail liquor license be granted.

A motion was made by Commissioner McCarthy and seconded by Commissioner Gooldy that the U. S. Forest Reserve check, amounting to \$8728.27, be divided as follows:

5% to general school fund, \$436.42, and 95% county general fund, \$8291.85.

Rev. H. K. Fulton, H. D. Peverly, and Miss Margaret Goodrich were appointed by the Board of Commissioners as directors of the Carbon County Museum.

Several matters concerning routine county business were disposed of.

At the request of Mina T. Woodhouse, County Treasurer, certificate of purchase #2882 was assigned to Curtis Templin for \$8.97.

The Board declared a vacancy exists in the office of Justice of Peace at Baggs, Wyoming, and appointed Mr. C. A. Kinney of Baggs, Wyoming, to fill this vacancy, on motion by Commissioner McCarthy, seconded by Commissioner Gooldy.
