

COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

Special Meeting.

Road

The Board of Commissioners met July 21, 1941 at 10:00 A.M. all present, John F. Gooldy presiding.

R. A. Hakala submitted his report as viewer of the proposed Baggs-Dixon highway.

A motion was made by McCarthy, seconded by Hansen and unanimously carried, adopting the following resolution:

Whereas,

The Board of County Commissioners of Carbon County, Wyoming, have decided to locate a road to be known as Baggs-Dixon commencing at a point which is S.89° 44'W. 843.7 feet from a point which is N.89° 52'W. 1319.5 feet from a point which is N.0° 02'W. 635.0 feet from the Southeast corner of Section 5, T. 12N., R. 91W. of the 6th P.M. Wyoming, thence in an Easterly direction through Sections 5, 4, 9, 10, 11 & 12, T. 12N., R. 91W of the 6th P. M. Wyoming; Sections 7, 8 and 5, T.12N., R.90W of the 6th P.M.Wyoming, to a point on the East boundary of said Section 5, T. 12N., R.90W., which point is S.88° 46'W. 60.3 feet from a point which is N.10° 54'E. 304.2 feet from the Southeast corner of said Section 5, T.12N., R.90W.

The proposed location and width of right of way required are set forth in detail on map on file with the County Clerk and may be examined at his office.

All objections thereto and claims for damages must be filed in writing with the County Clerk of said County before noon on the 14 day of August A. D. 1941, or such road will be established without reference to such objections or claims for damages.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned until August 4, 1941.
