

COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS
SPECIAL MEETING.

The Board of Commissioners met August 4, 1941, at 10:00 o'clock A. M., all members present, together with Deputy Assessor, R. A. Hakala, and County Attorney, J. J. Hickey, John F. Gooldy presiding.

Pursuant to the provisions of law, the Board of Commissioners met August 4, 1941 for the purpose of fixing the Tax Levies for and within Carbon County, Wyoming, for the year 1941.

Having received from the State Board of Equalization notice that the assessed valuation of Carbon County for the year 1941 had been found to be \$26,394,361.00 and that the State Tax Levy applicable to all assessed property within the State had been fixed at one and one-half mills, (1.5); and that the County Assessor had advised the Board of the assessed valuation of each of the various municipalities and School Districts within the County, the Board proceeded to fix the levies upon the assessed property of Carbon County for the year 1941 as follows:




