ON MOTION BY COMMISSIONER MCCARTHY, SECONDED BY HANSEN, A RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ASSESSOR TO PROCEED WITH THE COLLECTION OF POLL TAX FOR THE ENSUING YEAR, 1941.

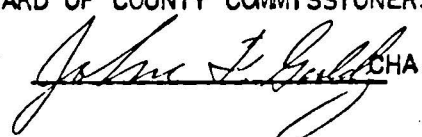
