TAX REBATE ORDER NO. 1440 was issued to Julius E. Nelson of Saratoga, Wyoming, in the amount of \$41.94 on account of erroneous assessment.

The following resolution was introduced by Commissioner McCarthy, seconded by Hansen and unanimously carried:

R E S O L U T I O N

BE IT RESOLVED that those certain agreements made and entered into on the 2nd day of December, 1941, by and between the Union Pacific Railroad Co., a corporation of the State of Utah, party of the first part and the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Carbon and State of Wyoming, party of the second part; and Susan J. Quealy, party of the first part and the Board of County Commissioners, party of the second part; Richards Brothers Incorporated, a corporation of the State of Wyoming, party of the first part and the Board of County Commissioners, party of the second part; with reference to the payment of rentals on certain lands leased to this Board, by the above named parties of the first part, be, and the same are hereby terminated, pursuant to Section 4, of the above named agreements made and entered into on the second day of December, 1941; and that the County Clerk of the County of Carbon, State of Wyoming, give notice in writing to the said parties of the first part, of the termination of said lease under said Section 4.
