Upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, the following primary election proclamation was made and ordered published and posted as required under Section 36-112, Wyoming Revised Statutes, of 1931.

A motion was made by Commissioner McCarthy, seconded by Hansen and unanimously carried, wherein Riverside voting precinct No. 3 in district 12, and French voting precinct No. 2 in district 13, were included in Justice Precinct No. 6; And election district No. 4, Lamont Precinct No. 1, Seminoe Dam Precinct No. 2, Marvin Precinct No. 3 and Station 8 Precinct No. 4 were included in Justice Precinct No. 1B.
