

COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

SPECIAL MEETING

The Board of Commissioners met January 19, 1942, at 10:00 o'clock A. M., all member present, John F. Gooldy presiding, for the purpose of hearing protests and claims for damages on the proposed Saratoga --- Encampment and Saratoga-Centennial Road. Protests and claims of damages were received from the following land owners:

William M. Powell, Arthur W. Mitchell, F. H. Davidson, Claus G. & Joseph W. Larson, Luke Shay, Minnie Doherty Saylor, George Graff, Kenneth Day and Mary Frances McKee, G. G. Cornell, J. V. Stitz, W. A. Tappan, Mrs. Mayme Aydelott, Mr. & Mrs. G. R. Tappan, John Wombaker, Ida Nickell, W. T. Peryam, A. M. Peryam and W. C. Condict.

In compliance with Sec. 52-219 W. R. S. 1931, a motion was made by McCarthy, seconded by Hansen and unanimously carried, whereby Isadore Bolten, John Quealy, and Frank Cooper were appointed as a board of appraisers to view and appraise the above mentioned road, as proposed, and make a report of their findings to the Board of County Commissioners as soon as practicable. It was also decided that the appraisers should meet at 9:00 A. M., January 26th & 27th with the various land owners at the Saratoga State Bank in Saratoga, Wyoming; also that all land owners and claimants along the proposed road be notified by the County Clerk. The Board suggested that the Board of Appraisers make the report to the County Clerk before the next regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners to be held February 3, 1942.

Thereupon the Board adjourned until February 2, 1942.
