BOND, of Elizabeth Swanson as Deputy County Treasurer, in the amount of \$2500.00 was approved.

CERTIFICATES OF PURCHASE, as follows were assigned by the Board:

The request of Harry E. Russell for purchase of C.P. No. 2942, was rejected by the Board.

A motion was made by Commissioner Gooldy, seconded by Cheesbrough and unanimously carried, whereby County Attorney, S. K. Briggs, was requested to obtain an opinion from the Attorney General regarding the legality of House Bills No. 98 & 105, as passed by the 1943 Legislature.

FOREST RESERVE FEES in the amount of \$9761.04, was apportioned as follows:

5% to School Districts, \$488.05, and 95% Road & Bridge Department, \$9272.99.

PETITION No. 1 was presented to the Board by the water users of the Upper Platte Valley, requesting that William H. Carey be retained as Water Commissioner for that district. By unanimous action of the Board it was decided to recommend this re-appointment to the District Water Commissioner.

Thereupon the Board adjourned until April 8th, 1943.

A motion was made by Commissioner Gooldy, seconded by Cheesbrough and unanimously carried, whereby the following Resolution was adopted:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the citizens of Carbon County, Wyoming, have protested to the Board of the County Commissioners of the County of Carbon, State of Wyoming, against Proclamation 2578 creating the Jackson Hole National Monument; and

WHEREAS, we consider said Proclamation to be against the best interests of the State of Wyoming.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of the County Commissioners of the County of Carbon, State of Wyoming, that Proclamation 2578, creating the Jackson Hole National Monument, be repealed, it being against the best interests of the State of Wyoming.

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this Resolution be forwarded to Honorable Joseph C. O'Mahoney and Honorable E. V. Robertson, United States Senators, and Honorable Frank A. Barrett, member of the United States House of Representatives.
