JANUARY 5, 1944

The Board resumed its session January 5, 1944, all present, Eugene McCarthy, Chairman.

TAX ABATEMENT of \$16.40 was allowed the Rawlins Silver Fox & Fur Farm, account erroneous assessment.
No protests or claims for damages were presented on the proposed Rawlins-Muddy Gap Road, on which
the hearing had been set for Jan. 5, 1944.

A motion was made, seconded and unanimously carried whereby a certain portion of the County
land in the vicinity of the County Fair Grounds was leased to the United States of America. The land in
question is further described in the contract entered into between Carbon County and the United States
of America and is on file in the Office of the County Clerk. Eugene McCarthy, Chairman of the Board of
Commissioners was authorized to make the Lease for and on behalf of Carbon County.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
