

The Board of Commissioners met January 22, 1945, at 2:00 p. m., all present, Eugene McCarthy presiding, for the purpose of receiving and hearing protests on the proposed relocation of a section of the Brush Creek-Saratoga Road.

Written protests were received from the land owners involved, namely W. C. Condict, Mary F. McKee and Kenneth Day, together with a protest from R. R. Crow & Co.

The Board decided to refer this matter to the State Highway Department and to send a copy of the protests to this department. No further action will be taken until the Board of Commissioners has been advised by the State Highway Department.


There being no further business, the Board adjourned until February 5, 1945, at which time the final action on the 1945 County Budget will be taken.
