That the present county road and bridge be abandoned and closed to the public, that the bridge be left in place for the convenience of local ranchers for a live stock crossing for access to the stockyards adjacent, for the convenience of Crow Lumber Co. in reaching their plant nearby, and accept waiver of damages of W. C. Condict because of the above.
