THE Board of County Commissioners, Carbon County, Wyoming met as a Board of Equalization at 10:00 A.M., 27 May 1946, as provided by Ch 115, Art 22, W.R.S., 1931. Miss Marie Spataro, Deputy County Assessor, acted as clerk of the Board.
